Steve Alan Kaufman was a former assistant of Andy Warhol and one of the major Pop Artists of his time. Inspired by great artists of the past, he developed his own artistic identity. In 1996, Kaufman wanted to show his respect for those great artists by creating a very special series of works dedicated to Da Vinci, Rembrandt, Van Gogh, Shakespeare, Mozart, and Ludwig van Beethoven.
